Early Intervention (EI): Your Rights

Your child can get therapy if they are under three and need help with how they walk, talk, learn, move, or behave. Children with lead exposure or a DCFS case may automatically qualify. **After you are referred to EI, you have the right to:**

- A phone call from your Child and Family Connections (CFC) within two business days to answer questions and schedule an intake
- A FREE evaluation of your child and an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) within 45 days of agreeing to the evaluation plan
- EI services that start no more than 30 days after you agree to your child's IFSP
